## BPS NEWSFLASH - 10 of 2021 Winter Break - 13 July 2021

Dear Parents and Guardians

On Sunday night, our State President announced that Level 4 restrictions would be in place for a further two weeks. In keeping with this, he further stated that all schools would now reopen on **26 July 2021**.

We have been assured by the WCED that Gazetted directives from the DBE will follow shortly. These will guide us as we plan the way forward at BPS. Our experience during last year has taught us that it is far better to wait for official notification, as our plans must be aligned with those of the national and provincial education departments. As soon as we receive clarity on these matters, we will communicate with you.

Even though our learners are still enjoying their much needed school break, we advise that regular reading should continue, as well as revision and consolidation of concepts learnt thus far. Senior Primary learners should keep revising for any Controlled Tests that could not be completed due to the unexpected early closure of schools last term. These will be written when Term Three commences.

Our After School Care (ASC) will remain closed for Holiday Care during the Winter Break and will reopen at the beginning of the third term.

On a positive note, the BPS staff has been vaccinated, and we certainly hope that this extra layer of protection will assist in bringing some sort of normality in the future. Parents and guardians are reminded that currently vaccination registrations are open for the age groups 50 and upwards, and will open for the age groups 35 and upwards on 15 July 2021.
