Dear Parents and Guardians

COVID-19:

The Department of Basic Education (DBE) has informed all Provincial Education Departments that all Public Schools will be utilised as COVID-19 vaccination sites for all learners of 12 years and older, as well as, educators and school support staff. This is a collaborative effort between the DBE, the Department of Health and various partners.

Parental consent will be required prior to learners being vaccinated at schools, in line with the procedures of the Integrated School Health Programme. When the Western Cape Department of Health and Wellness (WCDHW) have confirmed a date for the roll-out at BPS, we will distribute the consent forms.

Learners who wish to be vaccinated without the required parental consent, must be referred to a routine COVID-19 vaccination site.

HORIZON MATHS COMPETITION:

The prize giving for the Horizon Mathematics Competition took place at the Baxter Theatre last Thursday. Nationally, there were over 74 000 learners who wrote the exam, with 21 433 learners from 158 schools in the Western Cape. Of these, there were 2710 learners who qualified for the second round of the competition. Bergvliet Primary School had two learners that finished in the top 0,5% of the learners who participated.

Congratulations to Ethan Stemmers (7DS) who achieved 35th position and to Sinovuyo Nkayi (7DS), who achieved 59th position. We are very proud of your achievements. Thank you to Mrs. Esau for all of the preparation of our learners and for administrating the participation in the competition.
